



MAIN FEATURES

ROOM OCCUPANCY RATES FOR HOTELS AND MOTELS, ETC, WITH FACILITIES



SITE OCCUPANCY RATES FOR CARAVAN PARKS



During the 3 months ended September 1984, there were 1,048 licensed hotels with facilities and 2,811 motels, private hotels and guest houses with facilities in operation in Australia.

The room occupancy rate for hotels and motels etc. with facilities was 56.5% for the September quarter 1984 compared with 55.7% for the September quarter 1983. Accommodation takings for the September quarter 1984 were \$237m compared with \$208m for the September quarter 1983.

The site occupancy rate for caravan parks for the September quarter 1984 was 20.8% compared with 21.1% for the September quarter 1983.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains results, for Australia and each State and Territory, of the quarterly surveys of tourist accommodation establishments.

Scope and coverage

2. For the purposes of this survey, a tourist accommodation establishment is defined as an establishment which predominantly provides short term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) available to the general public.

- 3. The scope of the survey may vary from time to time depending upon the needs of users of the statistics and on the ABS resources available to undertake the surveys. The types of establishments currently included in the survey are:
 - (a) Licensed hotel with facilities. A tourist accommodation establishment which is licensed to operate a public bar, provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms, and has breakfast available for guests.
 - (b) Licensed or unlicensed motel, private hotel or guest house with facilities. A tourist accommodation establishment which provides bath or shower

- and toilet in most guest rooms and has breakfast available for guests but is not licensed to operate a public bar. This category also includes motels that are licensed to serve liquor with meals.
- (c) Caravan park. A tourist accommodation establishment which provides powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

Definitions

- 4. Number of establishments refers to the number of tourist accommodation establishments within the scope of the survey which operated during the survey period. Establishments comprising more than one type of accommodation activity referred to in paragraph 3 above (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two separate establishments. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter or which closed temporarily for the quarter because of seasonal reasons.
- 5. Guest rooms refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites, etc. available for accommodating paying guests at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period.
- 6. Bed spaces refers to the maximum number of guests that could be accommodated in beds normally in place (excluding cots) at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period. Three-quarter beds are classified as single beds; double beds are counted as 2 bed spaces.
- 7. Powered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply, available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period. Included are powered sites occupied by on-site vans.
- 8. Unpowered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power supply, available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.
- 9. Cabins, flats, etc. refers to the maximum number of cabins, flats, units and villas available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.
- 10. Total caravan park capacity refers to the maximum number of on-site vans, other powered sites, unpowered sites and cabins, flats, etc. available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.
- 11. Room occupancy rate refers to the proportion of guest rooms occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of guest rooms available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.
- 12. Bed occupancy rate refers to the proportion of bed spaces occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of bed spaces available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.


- 13. Site occupancy rate refers to the proportion of sites occupied by guests in caravan parks to the total caravan park capacity available during the survey period expressed as a percentage. Unoccupied on-site vans are treated as vacant sites.
- 14. Takings from accommodation refers to revenue received from the provision of short term and long term accommodation at the tourist accommodation establishment. Where meals and accommodation were a combined charge an estimate of takings from meals was excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month represent the takings received during that month. In the case of some establishments payments may be made in advance of, or may be received after the provision of accommodation to guests and therefore the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.
- 15. Employment. Details of the numbers of persons working at tourist accommodation establishments (including those working on other than accommodation activities) have not been included in this publication. However, data are available upon request from the ABS.

Related publications

- 16. Publications for Australia, and each State and Territory, are released by the respective offices of the ABS. Tourist accommodation statistics for past quarters are available in earlier publications commencing with the September quarter 1975. These and some unpublished statistics for certain small areas within States (e.g. local government areas or combinations of local government areas) are available upon request. From September Quarter 1980 a dissection of the statistics shown in this publication, according to size of establishment, is available on request for each State (Territories excluded).
- 17. Current publications produced by the ABS are listed in the Catalogue of Publications, Australia (1101.0). The ABS also issues on Tuesdays and Fridays, a Publications Advice (1105.0) which lists publications to be released in the next few days. The Catalogue and Publications Advice are available from any ABS office.

NOTE: Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and totals.






