Aged Care Minister Richard Colbeck's data snapshot released today makes the point that there were almost 1000 fewer deaths in aged care homes nationally during the first seven months of 2020 than the same period last year - 32,398 residents died between January 1 and July 31, 2020, 985 fewer deaths than the same period in 2019.

I note that hundreds more COVID-19 deaths have been recorded in the sector in the six weeks since, mostly in Victoria, which accounts for 95 per cent of the nation's aged care deaths.
