



KEY POINTS

ACCOMMODATION TAKINGS

- In June quarter 2008, the trend estimate of total accommodation takings for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms increased by 2.3% to \$2,014.2 million compared with March quarter 2008.
- Over the same period, the seasonally adjusted estimate increased by 2.9% to \$2,023.3 million.

ROOM OCCUPANCY RATE

- The trend estimate of the room occupancy rate for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms remained at 65.1% for June quarter 2008 compared to March quarter 2008.
- The room occupancy rate trend for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms had decreased for three consecutive quarters but has remained stable in the June 2008 quarter.
- The seasonally adjusted estimate increased 0.7 percentage points to 65.5% for June quarter 2008 compared with March quarter 2008.

ABOUT THIS ISSUE

This issue presents results from the June quarter 2008 Survey of Tourist Accommodation (STA) for the following categories of establishments:

- licensed hotels and resorts with facilities and 5 or more rooms
- motels, private hotels and guest houses with facilities and 5 or more rooms
- serviced apartments with 5 or more units
- caravan parks with 40 or more powered sites
- holiday flats, units and houses of letting entities with 15 or more rooms or units
- visitor hostels with 25 or more bed spaces.

DATA NOTES

As advised in the December quarter 2007 issue of this publication, Autoregressive Integrated Moving Averages (ARIMA) modelling has been incorporated into the seasonal adjustment process for the majority of the tourist accommodation series and all series have a changed treatment of the trading day component. As a result of these changes the seasonally adjusted and, to a lesser extent, the trend series have been revised. For further information, see paragraphs 22 and 23 of the Seasonal Adjustment section of the Explanatory Notes.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

ORIGINAL

Hotels, motels and serviced apartments


This summary contains key findings for original estimates. While trend and seasonally adjusted data are only available for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms, original estimates have two additional data series comprising hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 to 14 rooms and 5 or more rooms.

Original series are impacted by seasonal variations and irregular or non-seasonal influences and comparisons between quarters should be made with caution.

ACCOMMODATION TAKINGS

In June quarter 2008, accommodation takings were \$1,908.2 million for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 or more rooms, comprising \$1,838.3 million for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms and \$69.9 million for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 to 14 rooms.

TAKINGS FROM ACCOMMODATION, Hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 or more rooms—Australia




Accommodation takings in June quarter 2008 for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms were highest in New South Wales (\$580.1 million) and Queensland (\$465.5 million).

The June quarter 2008 average takings per room night occupied were \$144.53 for establishments with 5 or more rooms. This was heavily influenced by hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms which contribute 96.3% to total takings, and had an average takings per room night occupied of \$147.37. The average for 5 to 14 room establishments was \$95.94.

AVERAGE TAKINGS (a), Australia



ROOM OCCUPANCY RATE

The room occupancy rate for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 or more rooms was 60.7% in June quarter 2008. For hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms, the room occupancy rate was 62.1%, while demand for 5 to 14 room hotels, motels and serviced apartments was lower, as reflected by a room occupancy rate of 43.5%.

ROOM NIGHTS OCCUPIED

Room nights occupied were 13.2 million in June quarter 2008 for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 or more rooms. For hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms, room nights occupied were 12.5 million in June quarter 2008, while for establishments with 5 to 14 rooms, room nights occupied were 0.7 million.

New South Wales contributed the highest proportion (30.9%) of occupied rooms for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms, followed by Queensland at 27.1%.

Hotels, motels and serviced apartments continued

AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY

The average length of stay in June quarter 2008 for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with both 5 or more rooms and 15 or more rooms was 2.2 days. For establishments with 5 to 14 rooms, the average length of stay was 1.8 days.


Queensland (2.6 days) reported the longest average length of stay for hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms, followed by Western Australia (2.4 days). The shortest average length of stay was in Tasmania (1.9 days).

STAR GRADING

In June quarter 2008, the room occupancy rate for five-star hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 or more rooms was 70.4% compared with 29.7% for one-star. For hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms, the room occupancy rate was 70.6% for five-star establishments compared with 30.6% for one-star establishments.

In the 5-14 rooms category, three-star (48.0%) establishments had the highest room occupancy rates in June quarter 2008, compared with one-star establishments at 28.0%.

OCCUPANCY RATES, Stargrading - June Qtr 2008




In June quarter 2008, the average takings per room night occupied for five-star hotels, motels and serviced apartments with 5 or more rooms was \$243.17 compared with \$73.17 for one-star. In the 15 or more rooms category, the average takings was \$243.21 for five-star establishments compared with \$82.11 for one-star establishments.

For establishments with 5 to 14 rooms, five-star establishments had the highest average takings per room nights occupied of \$233.49, compared with one-star establishments at \$55.20.

Caravan parks, holiday flats, units and houses, and visitor hostels

ACCOMMODATION TAKINGS

In June quarter 2008, accommodation takings for caravan parks were \$229.3 million. New South Wales (\$70.4 million) had the highest accommodation takings for all caravan parks for June quarter 2008, contributing 30.7% of the total.

Short-term caravan park takings were \$188.5 million in June quarter 2008 which was 82.2% of total caravan park takings.

Accommodation takings for holiday flats, units and houses were \$115.2 million in June quarter 2008. Real estate takings accounted for 21.4% of total holiday flats, units and houses takings, the rest being for other letting entities.

For visitor hostels, accommodation takings were \$54.1 million in June quarter 2008.

OCCUPANCY RATE

The site occupancy rate for all caravan parks in June quarter 2008 was 51.1%. Short-term caravan park occupancy was 47.4% and long-term caravan park occupancy was 76.1%.


For holiday flats, units and houses, the unit occupancy rate was 39.3% in June quarter 2008.

The bed occupancy rate for visitor hostels in June quarter 2008 was 50.1%. Western Australia, Queensland and Northern Territory had the highest bed occupancy rates for visitor hostels in June quarter 2008 being 59.2%, 58.2% and 53.9% respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

SCOPE

- **1** This publication presents data from the quarterly Survey of Tourist Accommodation (STA). The STA is a mailout collection that completely enumerates all in-scope accommodation establishments within Australia.
- **2** From March quarter 2005, the scope of the STA comprises the following categories of establishments:
 - licensed hotels and resorts with facilities and 5 or more rooms
 - motels, private hotels and guest houses with facilities and 5 or more rooms
 - serviced apartments with 5 or more units
 - caravan parks with 40 or more powered sites
 - holiday flats, units and houses of letting entities with 15 or more rooms or units
 - visitor hostels with 25 or more bed spaces.
- **3** With the exception of caravan parks, these establishments provide predominantly short-term non-residential accommodation, i.e. accommodation which is not leased, and which is provided to guests who would generally stay for periods of less than two months. Some of these establishments also provide long-term residential accommodation. The amount of such activity is considered to be insignificant and is included in the data presented in this publication.
- **4** Caravan parks provide either short-term or long-term accommodation. If a caravan park has the majority of sites occupied by paying guests who have stayed continuously for two months or more during the survey period, the caravan park is classified as long-term. Data for caravan parks are presented by short-term and long-term in this publication.
- **5** Previous to March quarter 2005, the scope of the STA comprised:
 - licensed hotels and resorts with facilities and 15 or more rooms
 - motels, private hotels and guest houses with facilities and 15 or more rooms
 - serviced apartments with 15 or more units.
- **6** For the four quarters of 2000 and 2003, the scope of the STA was expanded to include:
 - caravan parks with 40 or more powered sites
 - holiday flats, units and houses of letting entities with 15 or more rooms or units
 - visitor hostels with 25 or more bed spaces.
- **7** The main source of coverage is from the Australian Automobile Association through AAA Tourism Pty Ltd. This is supplemented by notification of new tourism developments and their likely opening dates in selected guides, major tourism journals and periodicals and newspapers. Periodic comparison with lists of accommodation establishments provided by the various tourism organisations and industry associations is also undertaken.
- **8** From 1 July 2000, takings from accommodation include gross revenue from the provision of accommodation, including GST. Takings from meals are excluded. Where businesses are unable to provide the data inclusive of GST, it is automatically adjusted by the ABS prior to aggregation and release in output.
- **9** Star grade classifications of establishments are continuously revised by AAA Tourism Pty Ltd. This should be taken into account when making comparisons over time. STATISTICAL GEOGRAPHY

- **11** Small area statistics for 2008 are classified to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), 2007 Edition (cat. no. 1216.0). Data are coded to the statistical local area (SLA) level.
- 12 These SIA data are aggregated to tourism regions as defined by relevant state and territory tourism organisations. Tourism regions are reviewed annually and are subject to boundary and name changes. Where changes have occurred care should be taken when making comparisons with previously published data at this level.
- **13** Data by tourism regions are no longer presented in this publication. Small area data are provided in the data cubes that accompany this publication: Tourist Accommodation, Small Area Data (cat. no. 8635.0.55.002 for national data and cat. no. 8635.1.55.001 8635.8.55.001 for state/territory data).
- **14** Details of SLAs, the composition of tourism regions and maps of tourism regions are provided in the ABS publication Tourism Region Maps and Concordance Files, Australia (cat. no. 9503.0.55.001) available from the ABS web site <www.abs.gov.au>.
- 15 The survey does not have a sample component and the data are not subject to sampling variability. However, other inaccuracies collectively referred to as non-sampling error may affect the data. These non-sampling errors may arise from a number of sources, including:
 - errors in the reporting of data by providers
 - errors in the process of capturing data
 - imputation for missing data
 - definition and classification errors
 - incomplete coverage.
- **16** Every effort has been made to reduce non-sampling error to a minimum by careful design and testing of questionnaires, and efficient operating procedures and systems used to compile statistics.

SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT

20 Seasonal adjustment is a means of removing the estimated effects of normal seasonal variation from the original time series so that the effect of other influences on the series may be more clearly recognised. Seasonal adjustment procedures do not aim to remove the irregular or non-seasonal influences which may be present in any

particular quarter. Irregular influences that are highly volatile can make it difficult to interpret the movement of the series even after adjustment for seasonal variation, and cannot be assumed to indicate changes in the trend.

- **21** The seasonally adjusted estimates in this publication have been produced using a concurrent methodology whereby the seasonal factors are revised each month to take into account the seasonality exhibited by the latest observation. A more detailed review is conducted annually.
- 22 Recently, the ABS has implemented improved methods of producing seasonally adjusted estimates, focused on the application of Autoregressive Integrated Moving Average (ARIMA) modelling techniques. The revision properties of the seasonally adjusted and trend estimates can be improved by the use of ARIMA modelling. ARIMA modelling relies on the characteristics of the series being analysed to project future period data. The projected values are temporary, intermediate values, that are only used internally to improve the estimation of the seasonal factors. The projected data do not affect the original estimates and are discarded at the end of the seasonal adjustment process.
- 23 From the March quarter 2008, the Survey of Tourist Accommodation collection has implemented ARIMA modelling for the majority of applicable time series. For more information on the details of ARIMA modelling see the feature article 'Use of ARIMA modelling to reduce revisions' in the October 2004 issue of Australian Economic Indicators (cat. no. 1350.0). - 24 Smoothing the seasonally adjusted series reduces the impact of the irregular component of the seasonally adjusted series and creates the trend estimates. The trend estimates are derived by applying a 7-term Henderson moving average to the quarterly seasonally adjusted series. The Henderson moving average used in the middle of the time series is symmetric but, as the end of a time series is approached, asymmetric forms of the symmetric moving average are applied. Unlike the weights of the standard 7-term Henderson moving average, the weights used with the quarterly data have been tailored to suit the particular characteristics of individual series.
- **25** While these techniques enable trend estimates for the latest period to be produced, the process does result in revisions to the trend estimates in recent quarters, particularly as additional original estimates become available. For further information refer to Information Paper: A Guide to Interpreting Time Series Monitoring Trends, 2003 (cat. no. 1349.0) available at the ABS web site <www.abs.gov.au>.
- **26** Under the Census and Statistics Act, when releasing statistics the ABS is required to do this in a manner that is "not likely" (in a legal sense) to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation. A number of techniques are used to do this, including suppression of information. To ensure provider confidentiality in the Survey of Tourist Accommodation, the ABS uses a computerised process known as Disclosure Avoidance Analysis System (DAAS) to confidentialise the entire tourist accommodation dataset each quarter. This process not only ensures that data are suppressed to ensure individual establishments cannot be identified, but also suppresses data in other (consequential) cells to ensure data cannot be derived through deduction from the information available.
- **27** While the scope and coverage of the Survey of Tourist Accommodation has been expanded, priority has been given to maintaining the integrity and continuity of the core collection (hotels, motels and guest houses, and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms). In order to maximise data released from the core collection series and the new components of the expanded scope collection (hotels, motels and guest houses, and

serviced apartments with 5-14 rooms), the 'total' series (5 or more rooms) has been used for any consequential confidentiality required where possible.

28 The DAAS process begins by confidentialising at the Statistical Local Area (SLA) level, then across Tourism regions, then at the state level and finally the national level. If there is an SLA that has been made confidential then another SLA will have to be made confidential within that Tourism region to protect the confidentiality of the providers in the SLA that was originally made confidential. Depending on the number of SLAs in the Tourism region the whole Tourism region may need to be made confidential. As a consequence of this, at least one more Tourism region within a state or territory will also be confidentialised. This may also occur at the state/territory level.

USER AGGREGATION OF DATA

- 29 The aggregation of data by users across time periods should be undertaken with caution, due to the possibility of non-inclusion of confidentialised data (see the above section for more information about confidentialisation). Where one or more cells contributing to a total have been confidentialised (ie, contains the value of n.p.), the resulting aggregated total will be incorrect. However, some broader levels of data may not be affected by confidentialised cells.
- **30** Where data can be aggregated (ie, no confidentialised cells are included) for calendar and financial year/s purposes, the data items Establishments, Rooms, Persons employed and Bed spaces should not be aggregated. For these items it is recommended that for calendar years, the value of the December quarter is used, and for financial years, the value of the June quarter is used.
- **31** Any data items that have been derived from other items collected in the survey cannot be aggregated (ie, all those with labels ending in 'rate' or commencing with 'average'). These items must be re-derived based on the aggregation of each of the quarterly items collected in the survey used in the derivation of the rate or average (see Glossary for formulas).
- **32** Users are cautioned against deriving any non-standard aggregations (eg, aggregation of selected star gradings such as 4-star and 5-star; aggregation of selected geographical areas such as capital city areas and balance of state; aggregation of selected activities such as hotels and motels combined). This is because data are confidentialised based on the standard data item structure.

EFFECTS OF ROUNDING

33 Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between totals and the sum of the component items.

Multiple bedroom holiday The total number of holiday flats, units and houses available with multiple bedrooms. flats, units and houses

number of nights each room, unit or caravan park was occupied during the survey period.

Hotels

Occupancy in terms of guest nights refers to the total number of paying guests counted on each night they stayed at the accommodation establishment during the survey

period.

reserved

On-site vans The maximum number of vans owned or leased by the establishment for the purpose of

providing accommodation to the general public.

Other powered sites The maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply, available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period,

excluding powered sites occupied by on-site vans, and cabins, flats, units and villas.

The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, flats, units Other sites permanently

and villas continuously let for two months or more on the last day of the survey period to

tenants who occupy the sites only on a casual or sporadic basis.

Persons employed The total number of persons working at each accommodation establishment at the end

of the survey period (including working proprietors and those working on other than accommodation activities). This data item is not applicable to holiday flats, units and

houses let by real estate agents.

Room nights available The number of rooms/units available multiplied by the number of days for which they

> were available during the survey period. For establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during this period, operating periods only are included.

Room nights occupied The number of nights each guest room/unit was occupied by a paying guest during the

survey period.

Room occupancy rate The room occupancy rate represents room occupancy expressed as a percentage of total

capacity available during the survey period,

Room occupancy rate (%) = $\frac{Room\ nights\ occupied}{Room\ nights\ available}$

providing that, for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period, the denominator of the above expression includes only operating periods.

Rooms

The maximum number of rooms available for accommodating short-term paying guests at each licensed hotel and resort, motel and guest house and serviced apartment during the survey period. Units, apartments and suites are treated as rooms for these types of establishments in these survey results.

Serviced apartments

Establishments with five or more units which mostly comprise self-contained units at the same location, and which are available on a unit/apartment basis to the general public for a minimum of one night. The units should have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave), refrigerator and bath/shower and toilet facilities; all bed linen and towels should be provided, and daily servicing (i.e. cleaning and bed making) must be available through the on-site management, although this service may not necessarily be used.

Single bedroom holiday flats, units and houses

The total number of holiday flats, units and houses available with a single bedroom.

Site nights available

The number of caravan park sites available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period. For establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during this period, operating periods only are included.

Site nights occupied

The total number of nights each caravan park site was occupied during the survey period.

Site occupancy rate

The site occupancy rate for caravan parks represents site occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period,

Site occupancy rate (%) = $\frac{\text{Site nights occupied}}{\text{Site nights available}} * 100$

providing that, for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period, the denominator of the above expression includes only operating periods.

Sites occupied by long-term guests

The total number of caravan park sites occupied on the last day at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for two months or more.

Star grading

The grading of hotels, motels and guest houses with facilities and serviced apartments is based on the classification system owned by AAA Tourism Pty Ltd. The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the publication *Accommodation Guide* published by AAA Tourism Pty Ltd for each of the individual Australian Motoring Organisations. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).

While coverage has significantly improved, some establishments (including some competing in the four and five star markets and having significant takings) still remain outside the star grading scheme. These establishments have been given a star grading of 'ungraded'.

Takings from accommodation

Since 1 July 2000, takings from accommodation include gross revenue from the provision of accommodation, including GST. Takings from meals are excluded. In cases where takings from accommodation data cannot be provided inclusive of GST the amount of GST payable is estimated and the data revised accordingly.

Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month.

Unit lettings The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant,

counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant. This is the equivalent

of guest arrivals.

Unit nights available The number of holiday flats, units and houses available multiplied by the number of days

for which they were available during the survey period. For establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during this period, operating periods only are

included.

Unit nights occupied The total number of nights each holiday flat, unit or house was occupied during the

survey period.

Unit occupancy rate The unit occupancy rate for holiday flats, units and houses represents unit occupancy

expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period,

Unit occupancy rate (%) = $\frac{Unit \ nights \ occupied}{Unit \ nights \ available} * 100$

providing that, for letting entities closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period, the denominator of the above expression includes only

during the survey period, the denominator of the above expression includes only

operating periods.

Unpowered sites The maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power

supply, available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey

period.

Visitor hostels Establishments with 25 or more bed spaces which provide accommodation to visitors on

a bed basis (rather than by room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per

room basis.
