In 0709, 0710, 0711 and 0712 "vegetables" includes edible mushrooms, truffles, olives, capers, marrows, pumpkins, aubergines, sweet corn (*Zea mays* var. *saccharata*), fruits of the genus *Capsicum* or of the genus *Pimenta*, fennel, parsley, chervil, tarragon, cress and sweet marjoram (*Majorana hortensis* or *Origanum majorana*).
3. 0712 covers all dried vegetables of the kinds falling in 0701 to 0711, other than:
  - (a) dried leguminous vegetables, shelled (0713);
  - (b) sweet corn in the forms specified in 1102 to 1104;
  - (c) flour, meal, powder, flakes, granules and pellets of potatoes (1105);
  - (d) flour, meal and powder of the dried leguminous vegetables of 0713 (1106).
4. However, dried or crushed or ground fruits of the genus *Capsicum* or of the genus *Pimenta* are excluded from this Chapter (0904).

  - (a) dried leguminous vegetables, shelled (0713);
  - (b) sweet corn in the forms specified in 1102 to 1104;

  - (d) flour, meal and powder of the dried leguminous vegetables of 0713 (1106).

##### NOTES

  - (a) For additional preservation or stabilisation (e.g., by moderate heat treatment, sulphuring, the addition of sorbic acid or potassium sorbate),
  - (b) To improve or maintain their appearance (e.g., by the addition of vegetable oil or small quantities of glucose syrup), provided that they retain the character of dried fruit or dried nuts.
