Skilled Migration & Immigration

Used to develop skilled migration occupation lists to assist with visa programs.

Vocational Education & Training

Used to map skills, qualifications, and occupational outcomes to develop nationally recognised training.

Policy Development & Planning

Used to support formulation of policies and programs that address skill shortages in the workforce.

Labour Market Analysis

Used to produce statistics for the analysis of labour market trends and workforce planning.

Occupational Health & Safety

Used to compile occupational hazard information to assess impacts on occupational health and safety.

Public Health

Used in the analysis of job-related injuries, diseases and fatalities to determine health risk-factors.
